DESCRIPTION

Dörr-Tiralbit AL-E flam (Thickness 3.5 mm) is an elastomeric bitumen vapour control layer reinforced with a polyester-aluminium laminate and a glass fleece with longitudinal thread.

The top side is with quartz sand finely granulated and the bottom side is laminated with a polyethylene torch-foil. The top side longitudinal overlap area has an onesided PET-foil edge strip.
